

Under the No Child Left Behind Act (NCLB) school districts that do not meet state and/or federal targets for improving the achievement of all students are required to offer two options to parents. The Act gives parents of children enrolled in schools that receive Title I funding and that are identified in “School Improvement” the opportunity to transfer their children to a school **that is not** in school improvement. This is called Public School Choice (PSC) and offers parents of these students the ability to transfer their child(ren) to another school free of charge, and the district provides transportation.

In the Bedford City School District children who attend Columbus Intermediate School may attend Carylwood Intermediate School, and children who attend Central Primary School are allowed to attend Glendale Primary School and vice versa, using their public school choice option. Additionally, the No Child Left Behind Act allows parents who do not choose Public School Choice to use the option of Supplemental Educational Services (SES) for schools that are in year 2 of school improvement and above. Students eligible for Supplemental Educational Services (SES) are those students from low income families who attend a Title I served school in school improvement. Supplemental Educational Services are provided by organizations outside of the school district who are approved by the Ohio Department of Education. When a student’s school is a Title I served building that has not demonstrated Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP), parents have the opportunity to work with teachers and administrators in the school to identify their children’s needs and how these needs can be met with supplemental outside help or tutoring in the areas of reading, language arts and math.

The following is required by No Child Left Behind.

- The number of students who participated in Public School Choice for 2007-08 was 44 out of a possible 827; for 2008-09 it was 39 out of a possible 952; and for 2009-10 it was 41 out of a possible 416.
- The number of students who participated in Supplemental Educational Services for the 2008-09 school year was 123 out of a possible 521; and for 2009-10 it was 120 students out of a possible 261.
- The Bedford School District’s maximum allowable allocation for PSC and SES is \$195,370.54 for this school year. The district per child amount for SES is \$1,379.74.
