



### **BHS return to school plan:**

As we prepare for our return to school on Monday November 22 and Tuesday November 23rd, there are a few important changes that students will need to know. ALL STUDENTS AND VISITORS WILL ENTER VIA THE AUDITORIUM LOBBY DOORS.

#### **Morning Buses/Car Riders/Walkers/Student Drivers**

- \*Buses will be dropping students off at the front of the school (between the district office and front of the North House).
- \*Car riders will need to be dropped off on the Berwyn side of the building
- \*Students drivers will still park in the North parking lot (student area)
- \*Student walkers will walk and enter via the auditorium lobby doors.

#### **Student ID's**

- \*All students will be required to visibly wear their BHS student ID's
- \*Students who do not bring their ID will have a temporary ID for the day.
- \*Students that consistently do not have their ID will receive discipline

#### **Morning backpack check and walk through the metal detectors**

- \*Upon entering the building, students will open their backpacks and place items in it (cell phones, keys, phone chargers or anything that may set off the detector.
- \*Students will place their open bags/purses/backpack on the table to have them searched by security and walk through the metal detector. If cleared, students will get the bag/purse or backpack and report to the auditorium.

\*Students who do not clear the metal detector the first time will be asked to check the pockets for any materials and walk through for a second time. If cleared they report to the auditorium.

\*Students who do not clear after the 2nd time will step to the side to be wanded by security. Students who do not clear the wandling will be taken to a designated room with security to further investigate.

### **Auditorium and breakfast**

\*All students will enter the auditorium.

\*Students will have the option to eat breakfast starting at 7:20 am. Students that eat breakfast will remain in the cafeteria until the dismissal bell rings.

\*Students who do not eat breakfast will remain in the auditorium until the dismissal bell.

### **Dismissal to 1st period**

\*Students will exit the auditorium and report to their lockers if needed.

\*All students will be in their first period classroom before 7:45 am

### **End of the day dismissal**

\*Bus riders will be dismissed to their bus at 2:18 pm

\*Students will have 7 minutes to report to their locker and arrive at their bus.

\*Buses will leave BHS at 2:25 pm daily

\*Car riders, student drivers and walkers will dismiss at the 2:20 pm bell.
